### Tips & advice

Before you start knitting, we recommend you to practice the different techniques and stitches with its tutorial videos, especially if it's the first time you knit. You can find the videos in our website [weareknitters.com](http://weareknitters.com)

If you don't get it at your first try, don't worry, it's very common. Watch the video with your needles and wool in your hands as many times as you may need.

### Wool care instructions

Because WE ARE KNITTERS' wool is 100% wool, we recommend you to wash your garment using cold water and mild soap. Dry flat. To learn more about WE ARE KNITTERS' wool, read the CONCEPT area in our website.

### Stitch sample

It is important to do a sample before start knitting your project. The sample should measure 10cm x 10cm and needs to be done in Stockinette Stitch. If it comes out to be smaller, you will need to knit more loose, and if it comes out bigger, you will need to tight more the stitches.

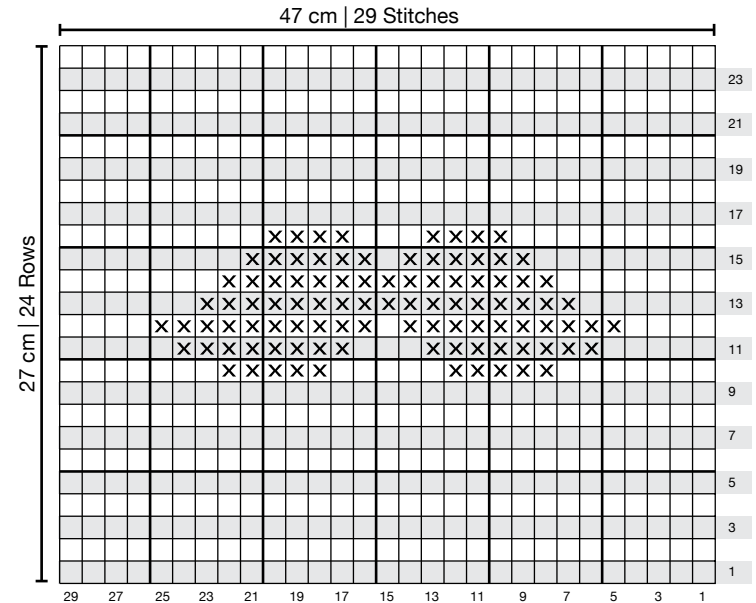
Stitch sample:

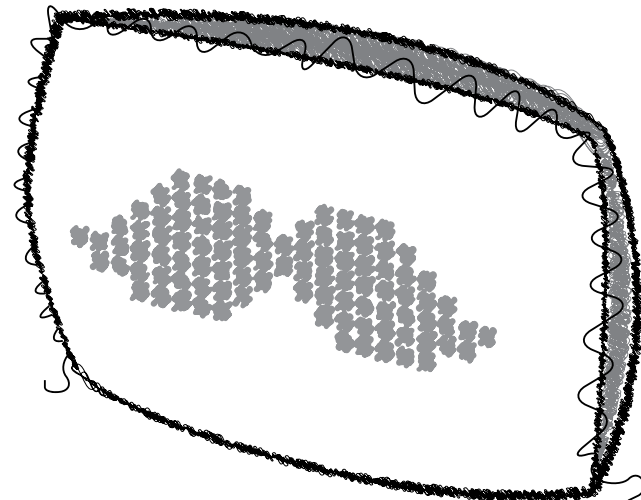

# MOVEMBER PILLOW

This project is knitted in one piece, but with two different colors: A & B. Once it is completed you will join both ends together.

## START KNITTING

1. Cast on 29 stitches with color A onto one of the wooden needles.
2. Knit rows 1 to 24 in Stockinette Stitch with color A:  
  
Odd rows: knit all the stitches.  
  
Even rows: purl all the stitches.
3. Change to color B and knit rows 25 to 48 again in Stockinette Stitch.
4. Cast off all stitches.

## HOW TO END YOUR PROJECT

1. Start embroider your mustache with color

A on the side of color B. Help yourself with the little sewing needle and the following scheme.

2. Do the same step with color B but on the side of color A.
3. In order to finish your pillow, cast off the stitches on both sides with your little sewing needle. Leave a little hole on the project to stuff the pillow afterwards.
4. Finish knitting your pillow; tie a knot and hide the remaining threads between the knitted stitches.

## WAK WOOL

The WE ARE KNITTERS' wool is 100% natural. Its softness is due to its origin: the Peruvian Andes. Over there, sheep live in optimal conditions, allowing the production of top quality wool. 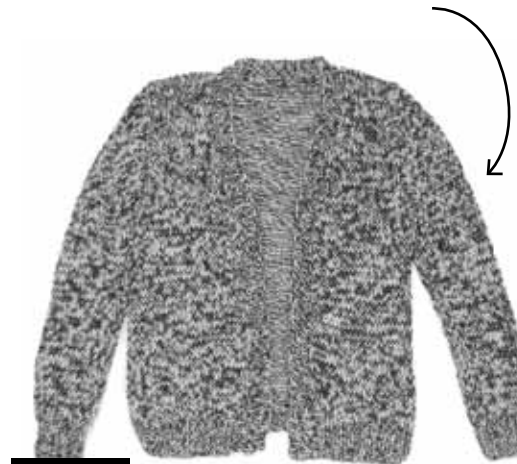
