## Tips & advice

### START CROCHETING

Before starting to crochet, we always recommend you practice the technique with our video tutorials on the blog. This is good advice, especially if it's your first time crocheting! You can find our videos on: [weareknitters.com](http://weareknitters.com)

If you don't get it on your first try, don't worry, it's very common. Watch the video with your needles and wool in your hands as many times as you may need.

## Cotton care instructions

The 100% Pima cotton is the best in the world. This is why we recommend that you handwash your final project with cold water and mild soap. Lay your garment flat to dry. 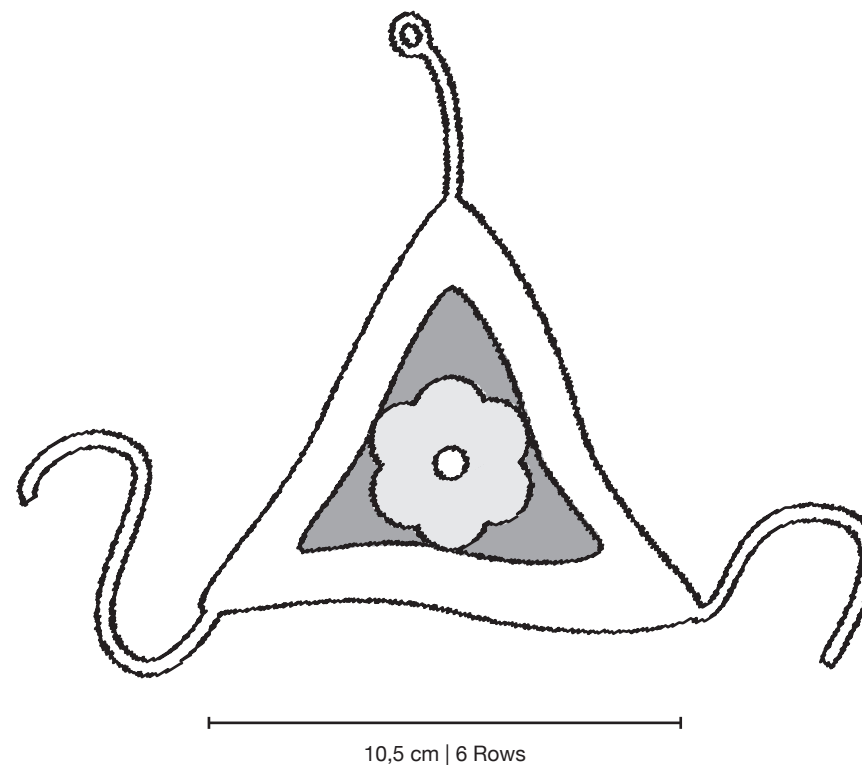
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## Stitch type

In order to start your project, you will need to crochet in double crochet. If you may need more help, please watch our videos on 'crochet techniques' on our video tutorial section on [weareknitters.com](http://weareknitters.com)

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# PAMPA SANDALS

This project is crocheted in a circular fashion and in three colors (A, B and C).

In order to crochet this project you are going to need the following stitches:

Chains: go around the hook with the thread and then pull it out of the stitch.

Double crochet: go around the hook with the thread in the third chain and then go around the hook with the thread again. Take out the hook with three threads. Go around the hook with the thread and pass it through the first two threads. Go around the hook again and pass it through the rest of the threads.

Three closed double crochets together: \*go around the hook with the thread and introduce it into the petal. Go around the hook with the thread again and pull it out with the three threads. Go around the hook with the thread and pass it through the first two threads. You will have two threads on the hook.\* Repeat from \* to \* two times. Now you have 4 threads on the hook. Go around the hook with the thread again and pass it through the 4 threads.

Three closed treble crochets together: go around the hook with the thread two times. Introduce the needle with the thread into the petal and go around the hook with the thread again. Pull the hook out with the 4 threads. Go around the hook with the thread and pass it through the first two threads. Go around the hook with the thread and pass it through the next two threads. You will have 2 threads on the hook. Go around the hook with the needle two times. Introduce the needle into the petal and go around the hook with the thread again. Pull the hook out with the 5 threads. Go around the hook with the thread and pass it through the first two threads.

Introduce the needle into the petal and go around the hook with the thread again. Pull the hook out with the 5 threads. Go around the hook with the thread and pass it through the first two threads. Go around the hook with the thread and pass it through the next

two threads. You will have 4 threads on the hook. Go around the hook with the thread and pass it through the 4 threads.

## START CROCHETING

1. With your WAK crochet hook, cast on 4 chains in color A.

2. In order to form a ring, crochet a slip stitch to the first chain so that the ring is closed. Crochet 3 chains to go on to the next round.

3. Crochet the first round as follows:

Round 1: form 11 double crochets into the inside of the ring formed by the chains.

4. Change to color B and crochet round 2 as follows:

Round 2: Crochet 4 chains and join them to the second chain of the previous round with a slip stitch. Repeat this until the end of the round. Make a slip stitch to join the first stitch to the last so that you have a total of 6 petals with a space of a chain between each of them. Crochet 3 chains.

5. Continue with color B and crochet round 3 as follows:

Row 3: In the first petal make 2 closed double crochets together with the chain of the previous row, make three chains, 3 closed treble crochets together, 3 chains, 3 closed double crochets together. \*Make 7 chains, skipping one petal. Make 3 closed double crochets together, make 3 chains, 3 closed double crochets together, 3 chains, 3 closed double crochet together. \* Repeat from \* to \* for the rest of the round in a way where you only crochet in 3 petals and leave the other 3 free. Join the first stitch with the last stitch with a slip stitch.

6. Change to color C and crochet round 4 as follows:

Round 4: crochet 4 chains, 4 double crochets in the hole of the previous round, 4 chains and 4 double crochets in the hole of previous round. Make 4 chains and a slip stitch to join rounds 2 and 3 with round 4. Repeat this until you have completed the round. When you have finished the round, join the first to the last stitch with the help of a slip stitch.

7. Now we are going to finish the rim of your sandal and crochet the straps. In order to do so continue with color C and crochet round 5 as follows: Round 5: crochet 6 slip stitches, make 30 chains and crochet a slip stitch into each of them. Crochet 20 slip stitches, make 18 chains. Count 10 stitches starting at the last and make a slip stitch to create the sling to close the sandal later on. Crochet 7 slip stitches to the strap until you get to the sandal again. Crochet 20 slip stitches. Make 30 chains and crochet a slip stitch into each of them. Crochet the rest of the round in slip stitch.

## HOW TO END YOUR PROJECT

1. After crocheting 6 rounds cut the thread 10 cm from the end and pull the remaining thread from your hook until you have taken out the stitch.

2. Thread the yarn through the knitter's sewing needle and hide the remaining yarn between the stitches of the crocheted garment.
